Brief summary	You will collect information about the town, make contributions to our E-Portfolio and assign to a group.

Individual Contribution	<p>Have a look at the website of the town's Tourist Centre and get a closer look at Stralsund. Is there anything you have not known about the town before? What interests you most – the history, the museums</p> <p>Write a short paragraph about the town using the prompts above and post it in your blog in ILIAS.</p> <p>Decide on the topic you want to work on for the next tasks and assign yourself to the appropriate group. You can choose between: history, sights, eating out, nightlife and sports. Each group shall not have more than 3 members.</p> <p>The task should be completed within the next 4 days.</p>
Dialogue begins	After posting your blog entry have a look at the other contributions. Maybe you can find someone with the same interests so you can work together. Choose one or two contributions and write a short reply. It shall not exceed 100 words. The task should be completed by the end of the week.

E-moderator interventions	The E-moderator will read all contributions and of course on the SOS-Forum in case students need help with the task or with the technical aspects of ILIAS.
Time schedule	Study time will be about 5-6 hours a week.
