Content: Showing people around a town

Media: photos, videos, Learning Management System ILIAS

Title	My place is the best!
Purpose	In this task you will enhance your ability to prioritize information in your group and start preparing your interactive map.
Brief summary	When the task is completed you will have an interactive map with a collection of information on the topic of your group.

Dialogue begins	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>2. In groups, discuss which information and material you want to use on your interactive map.</li><li>3. Make a list and decide on a route for a tour on the given map of town.</li><li>4. Devide the information. Who will work on which part.</li><li>5. Decide how you want to present the tour. Shall it be a written text next to the map with hotspots or do you want to record and audio file with the directions where to find the hotspots?</li></ol>
Individual contributions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>6. Have a look at your wiki contributions. Can you use them like this? Do you need to shorten them?</li><li>7. Create the items on the map.</li></ol>
Dialogue	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>8. Use the chatroom for your exchange.</li><li>9. Make sure at the end you have a tour around the town with different hotspots with information.</li></ol>

	You will have one week to prepare your interactive map and the tour.
